How to receive a one year free membership?

Objective

The main objective is to start up an active <u>national water network</u> that shares expertise among water professionals in Ecuador. In this context, three <u>activities</u>* will be organized in Ecuador during 2020, in which support from local water professionals is needed. Therefore, we like to offer the diverse benefits of IWA to 100 water professionals based on their promising contribution to these activities and their support to further develop the <u>Ecuadorian National Chapter of the International Water Association</u> during the coming years. Up to <u>100 free memberships</u> for IWA are available.

Deadline

Deadline for this call is Friday 15 November 2019, 7 pm (Ecuadorian time).

Who can apply?

The call is only open to <u>Ecuadorian citizens</u>, studying or working in a domain related to water technology or management. The jury will seek a balance among age, gender and type of organization (academic, research center, industry, government), to create a solid and diverse foundation for activity support and meeting attendance.

How to apply?

- 1. Include the following <u>personal information</u> at the top of your application:
 - Name of applicant
 - Organization
 - Address (street, street number, city, region)
 - Email
 - Phone number
 - Gender
 - Date of birth
 - Webpage of the university/company/organization
 - Brief study or job description (2-3 lines).
- 2. Show your motivation by answering the following five questions. We prefer that you answer the questions in English, but Spanish is also allowed.
 - a. Why do you think a national water association is needed in Ecuador?
 - b. How do you think to contribute to the organization of national meetings and this national water association in general?
 - c. How are you linked to water technology and management in your studies or professional activities?
 - d. How do you think that this membership can contribute to your professional activities and your personal career?

- June-August 2020: Innovation in water monitoring and assessment in Ibarra
- September-November 2020: Sustainable water use conference in Quito
